## Route BARRANCO DE LA HOZ

We take the beginning of the route in the mouth of the Carbo River, in the lower area of the town, also known as a recreational area.

From here we will go to the entrance of the Barranco de la hoz, on the side left where we will find the reclamation land apple. Crossing under the new bridge of the CV-175 road.

To enter the path, as soon as you arrive to the oldest bridge, we will go up the track located to the right that will lead to the top. Us we will enter the place of the Hoz, following the path that starts from the side of the same bridge.

At the beginning of the trail, we will be surprised the imposing rocks that encase to the ravine

In them we can appreciate the amount of birds that use their cracks for breeding, as well as mountain goats for seek shelter.

The route runs over the old canal in several sections. we'll get to a point where the ravine widens, discovering a landscape of great beauty that deserves to behold.

We can also see some of the plants that populate this corner and that will delight anyone fond of botany, for the great biodiversity.

Later we will see some stones forming stairs that will help us to go up to the bridge known as; Roman Bridge, the which era is unknown.

Once on the bridge, we take the steep concrete track left to go to the urban core. When arriving at the population we will go, for in front of the laundry room turning right to go up to the square City hall.

After recovering from the climb, we will go up the C/Olmos to get to the square de la Church.

Once there, we can go down the stairway that will lead us to the river Villahermosa, place where we have started the route.

Or we can stay in the same square of the Church and end the route of the Ravine of the Hoz.
