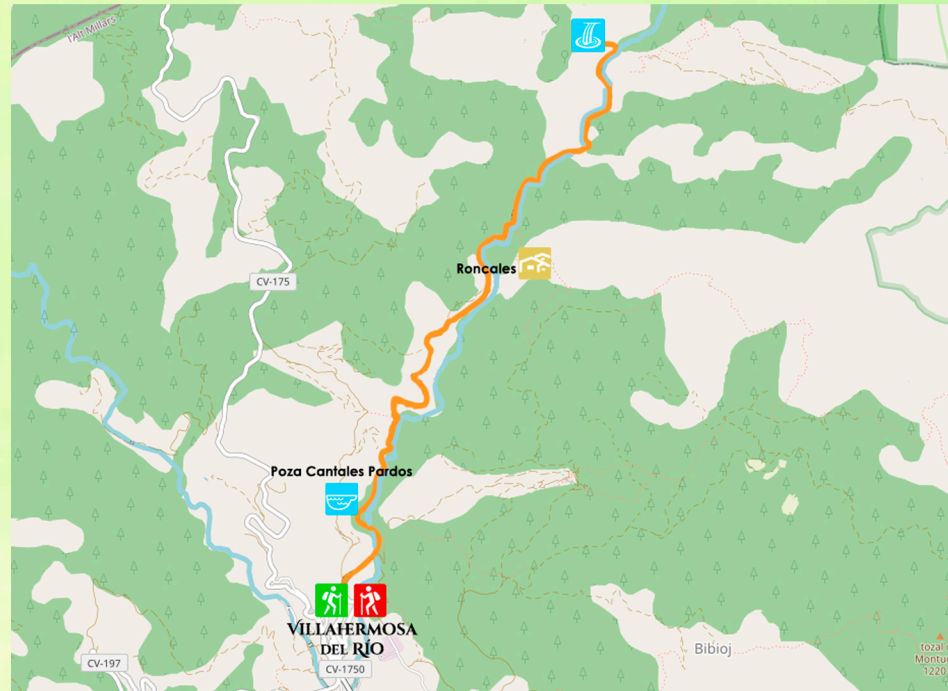

# Ruta CASCADA RÍO CARBO



The route begins in the Plaza de la Iglesia (tourist office), crossing the town until we reach the track that leads us to the River.

We follow the directions along the channel taking into account that We will cross the river several times.

In this section we will pass through the Cantales Pardos, one of the different pools that we will meet along the route.

In about 3km, we will arrive at the Masía Roncales, place where visitors who have wanted start the route from this point are incorporated after leaving his vehicle on the concrete track.

We continue along the path, leaving the river at our right.

During the journey we will pass through one of the old mills, different waterfalls water and through various pools, such as the Pozo Black.

Once we are at the highest point we can see the waterfall in the distance, hidden among the vegetation and rocks.

Before starting the descent to the waterfall we will find an indicative arrow for visitors who want to access the peak Peñagolosa where he shows them the deviation to start this path.

Following our route we begin the descent along the path, which leads us to the waterfall and its access.

The type of soil, orientation and altitude, among other factors, favor diversity of the

landscape and the rich variety of species that we can find throughout the route path.

The fauna that inhabits it is unique to the Valencian Community.

The channel is surrounded by ravines rocky with limestone that let their water and whose depth favors the ambient humidity.

The Carbo River is at the foot of the Peñagolosa, within the term of Villahermosa del Rio.

The course of the river and the landscape that surrounds it is of great beauty, worthy of being protected and conserved.

The diversity of plant species, animals and their geology favor the visitor can enjoy along the way.
