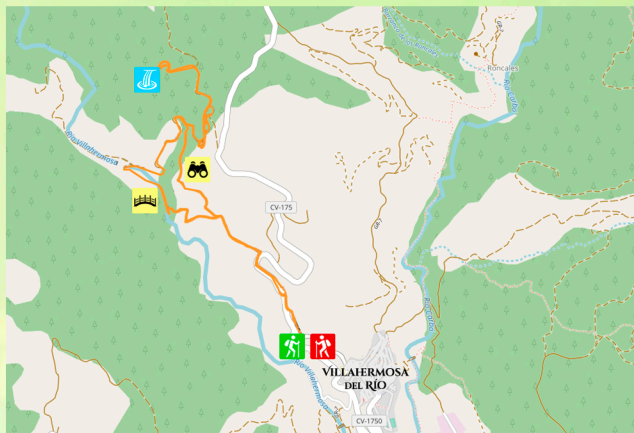

Route CASCADA LA TOSCA

Discover the small area of La Tosca



The route begins at the foot of the hermitage of San Antonio Abat. The trail runs to the right and connects with the CV-175 road through which we walked a few meters until we found the signal that indicates the beginning of the path. We continue with the reference of the arrows indications to the area of La Palanca, a small wooden bridge helps us to cross the river.

We follow the marked path until we cross a bridge from which we access a track, starting the steepest part of the Once at the top, we enter towards the left on the path that leads to the final stretch of Paraje de la Tosca.

We return along the path, until we find a sign that diverts us to the left, heading

towards the balcony of the Peña la Zaica, from where we can admire the Mountain river landscape. The Río Montaña area is located in one of the most beautiful stretches of the river Villahermosa.

The Barranco del Regajo, provides flow, creating a small waterfall and a pool, La Tosca, natural cave formed by from water erosion and in which we can appreciate calcareous formations such as stalagmites and stalactites.

The process of formation of this little place is the result of the passage of thousands of years and the action of water. The geological formations of the cave more abundant form capricious forms of rough rock, worthy of admiration.

Small cavities along the route with stalactites, stalagmites and petrified flora, lead us to discover the beautiful waterfall nature inside.

In the surroundings of the area live several animal species such as the mountain goat (Pyrenean capra), the wild boar (*sus scrofa*), the fox (*vulpes vulpes*) and the short-toed eagle (*circaetus gallicus*).

The inhabitants of the nearby farmhouses came to by rough stone to make the ovens where they made bread, so important in those years.

In addition to being a water source, it was used for irrigation of the surrounding orchards.

In the Civil War this cave saved many lives, because the neighbors hid there and kept safe, also kept animals and hid all kinds of food.
