



Starting from the refuge, we begin the ascent towards the highest point of Altís, following the track, 1.2km away, at the third curve we will take the detour towards the left marked by the signaling, where we will continue our road until reaching the highest point (1,300m altitude).

During the ascent, we will find a natural cavity known as the Cueva del Moro.

From when we started the climb until we started the descent, we can enjoy the magnificent views of the term municipal, including in front the Peñagolosa peak (1,813m) from the different natural viewpoints that we find in this stretch.

Then begins the descent that following the indications, takes us back to the refuge from where we have started the climb.


Arriving, we find a detour to the right, which leads us to the Fuente de Altís (300m), a place where we can take a break and stop to watch the magnificent landscape that nature gives us.
















The most abundant vegetation that found are pine forests, oaks, junipers and wild roses. Also other species Mediterranean such as thyme, and rosemary they are present all the way.

Due to its proximity to the Villahermosa vulture and the favorable height of Mount Altis, is very common to see species such as the vulture griffon, the golden eagle, the mountain goat the wild pig.
